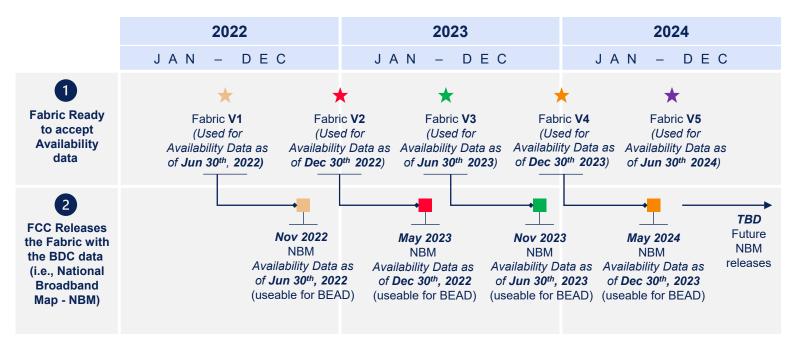

OVERVIEW

The timeline below **highlights** the FCC National Broadband Map's **two main components** (fabric and availability data) and **release schedule** and is intended to help Eligible Entities conduct the **BEAD Challenge Process**. Eligible Entities must stay aware of Fabric and Broadband Availability Map **release dates** to facilitate the **optional "true-up" process** and ensure the precision of the data used to make **BEAD subgrants**.

FABRIC & BROADBAND DATA COLLECTION (BDC) TIMELINE





Please note:

- Fabric Version 4 (Used for "Availability Data As Of" Dec 30th, 2023) will
 not be available for BEAD use until the upcoming National Broadband Map
 release (~ May 2024)
- Every two weeks, broadband availability updates are made to the National Broadband Map (i.e., "Last Updated" Date)
- Fabric and Availability Challenges can happen throughout the lifecycle of each Fabric version

IMPORTANT CONCEPTS



BDC-Fabric Integration: Eligible Entities may have access to a Fabric version before it has been released publicly on the National Broadband Map. A Fabric version may not be used for the purpose of the BEAD Challenge Process until it has been published with associated Availability Data.



"True-up" Dependency: Eligible Entities cannot perform the 'true-up' process to the most recently released Fabric until the associated availability data is published.
