	Barriers to planning for broadband infrastructure deployment included 1.) The initial grant writer & grant application partner passed away, so new technical advisors and engineering partners need to be found. We have secured Technical advisory support. 2.) Broadband access has changed since the initial application. New planning is underway to determine the best path forward to create a robust and resilient network for the Bridgeport tribe. 3.) Capacity challenges and leadership changes on the Tribal side have limited the project's progress at times. New leadership is in place and capacity challenges are under discussion.

	Our project promotes the NOFO purpose area of planning, by facilitating discussions with tribal leadership and existing internet service providers to determine the best path forward toward a robust broadband network that will meet expectations in terms of performance and resilience. Planning activities are currently underway, though not yet complete.

	We have undertaken important tribal conversations about the goals for the Bridgeport broadband network. We have secured technical advisory assistance and have begun to identify the engineering and environmental partners who can help us with the remaining NTIA-approved activities in our planning grant.
