The assessment and drafting of the contractual agreements has been slow due to the various parties involved. ITCN is in need of additional guidance and support from NTIA and Dept. of Commerce to move through the initial phases, as well as assistance with turnover in staffing and hardships caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.

(600 words or less) Yes, ITCN has connected NOFO purpose areas under the broadband infrastructure deployment and working through the initial phases to begin.
