Since that time, the Jicarilla Apache Nation Power Authority (JANPA) has executed an engineering contract with JSI, started the environmental review process and initiated high level designs of the proposed fiber routes. JANPA has also selected an environmental consultant to prepare a Catex request report for submission to NTIA.</p>

(600 words or less)</p> <p>Yes, the Jicarilla Apache Nation's project connects to the NOFO purpose area for broadband infrastructure work. This project is located within the town of Dulce, New Mexico and will serve 1,500 to 1,800 residences and businesses. It will allow the community and businesses to have a more reliable and faster type internet to communicate with the outside world. This project will facilitate more economic development for community members, vendors and contractors throughout the reservation area. The Jicarilla Apache Nation has always been on the tail end of the telecommunications spectrum and bringing fiber optic capability to our Tribal Nation will allow us to better both ourselves and the community as a whole.</p>

(600 words or less)</p> <p>The Jicarilla Apache Nation Power Authority has met and discussed our NTIA grant scope of work and project objectives with tribal leaders and passed multiple Legislative Council Resolutions to be able to carve the path forward for our telecommunications needs and secure the necessary administrative infrastructure. Throughout this initial start up reporting period, we have engaged our engineers/consultants on the design and environmental aspect of this project in order to begin construction by Fall 2023.</p>
