3	Levos Group LLC - Levos Group is a highly experienced team of experts that are providing administrative oversight for the Kickapoo fiber project. For the duration of the grant period, they will be assisting the Tribe in completing financial and programmatic tracking and reporting, as well as generating and overseeing completion of contracts with other subcontractors. Levos Group answers directly to Mr. Richard McKinney, Director of the Kickapoo Fiber Project. Grey Snow Communications LLC - GSC has been brought on to the project to provide technical oversight. Currently, they provide direction and fact-checking for all technical aspects of the project. Grant funds have been expended to provide salary and benefits for Mr. McKinney, Director of the Kickapoo Fiber Project, and contractor fees for Levos Group and Grey Snow Communications. This award includes no subrecipients.

4	To date, grant funds have been expended to provide salary and benefits for Mr. McKinney, Director of the Kickapoo Fiber Project, and contractor fees for Levos Group and Grey Snow Communications. This award includes no subrecipients.

6	As this project is still in the planning stage, physical barriers to infrastructure deployment have not presented themselves as yet. However, as a rural community, the Kickapoo Tribe continues to find it difficult to garner enough bids to complete competitive procurement process. To overcome this, the bid process has been extended beyond its typical period and the Tribe has relied on its Tribal community, including neighboring tribes, to spread RFP's and similar postings.

7	NOFO purpose areas were considered during the development of the Kickapoo's application for funding. However, since work has not yet begun in earnest on this project, there is nothing to remark on at this time.

8	During the current reporting period, Levos Group and Grey Snow Communications were brought on through competitive bid to provide project management services. These two groups have assisted in providing an updated Initial Expenditure Plan and the preparation of this annual report. In addition, Grey Snow Communications has provided direction on the technical aspects of the project including a potential budget revision which will allow the Tribe to provide more services to its members at a lower price point. A			

competitive bid process is underway for engineering and design teams as well as construction companies.
