	The Doyon, Limited Fiberoptic Project began the environmental assessment in March 2023 and no broadband services are yet available. The Fiberoptic Project will provide high speed internet, as well as the backbone infrastructure for future internet services, on the Yukon River, from the Yukon River bridge up river 175 miles to the communities of Fort Yukon, Beaver and Stevens Village. The fiber will also run down river from the Yukon River bridge for 122 miles to the communities of Rampart and Tanana.

	The Doyon, Limited Fiberoptic Project began the environmental assessment in March 2023. Engineering and procurement activities are underway. Construction has not started to date.

	Doyon, Limited's main contractor is Deploycom. Deploycom has submitted one invoice to date for 2.14 million and that includes engineering, environmental activities and procurement costs, all directly associated with the project.

	Doyon, Limited submitted its first grant draw on July 25, 2023 and the funds were drawn to pay subcontractor, Deploycom, for the work done to date.
